Instead, after considering various options, we are grieving the last days of a beloved Christian community.

Once again, the philosophy of Beatle John Lennon comes to mind. "Life is what happens to you while you're busy making other plans".

A few words from the Book of Proverbs also come to mind.

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge God, and God will make straight your paths.

Proverbs3:5-6

I believe the 75-year Westview journey is one marked by trust in God right up to the end. As you reflect on your part of the journey, I'm sure you can recall many signs of God's guiding Spirit along the way. People and events will spring to mind. You will remember family and friends who sat in the pews with you, as well as ministers and musicians who led you in worship. Dinners and parties. Bazaars and yard sales. You will remember the smiles and tears of weddings, baptisms and funerals. And so much more.

Though ministry at Westview will soon end, Christ Jesus will continue his ministry through his church. You will find new places to worship and the proceeds from the sale of the Westview building will contribute to Indigenous Ministries across Canada, support ministries within the Presbytery of East Toronto, and spark hope in Presbyterian congregations across the land who receive various kinds of funding from national agencies. Like the story of Easter, through death springs new life.

It has been a blessing for me to serve this congregation. I am deeply grateful to the elders for the faithful and loving way they fulfilled their duties. I feel I must single out Cathy, Glen, Nick, and Phyllis, who humbly and happily provided spiritual, administrative, technical and musical support that enabled Westview to continue ministry, week ... after week ... after week ... through this final vacancy and the darkest days of COVID.

As the final days slip by, I encourage you to ponder the words of Jesus when he said, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." John 14:27

The Westview congregation has had to make the difficult decision to dissolve (close) Westview Presbyterian Church, and this was approved by the Toronto East Presbytery on Tuesday October 3 2023. This dissolution (closing) will be effective December 31, 2023. It is indeed a time of great sadness, but also an opportunity for individual renewal of faith and service for the people of Westview.

<u>Our final worship service will be held on Sunday November 26 2023 at 9:30 a.m</u>. It will be held inperson, but also broadcast online for those that are unable to attend. You are all invited to join us and give thanks for our church family and celebrate the Lord's work that has taken place through us since 1948.




